

Volunteer Policy

To encourage the PBSA families to volunteer at the concession stand or other permitted activities we have instituted a "Hold Check" policy that will require each participant to provide a \$100 check (per player) at uniform pickup.

Volunteers will be required to either work one shift at the concession stand or complete an approved field maintenance activity per player. Meaning if you have one player you are required to work one shift if you have two players you are required to work two shifts. These shifts can occur at any scheduled time and can be completed by any member of your family 14 or older. Once the volunteer activity has been completed, the PBSA will destroy the checks. A sign-up site will be provided once the schedule has been created. If you have a specialized skill or would like to apply your volunteer activities to field maintenance/improvement you can contact our Director of Facilities to inquire about completing your volunteer hours that way. If you are scheduled to work a shift and get rained out, you will be given credit for that shift.

Only Board Members and Head Coaches are exempt from this policy. Additional exceptions to this policy can only be granted through official communication with the PBSA Secretary or PBSA President.
